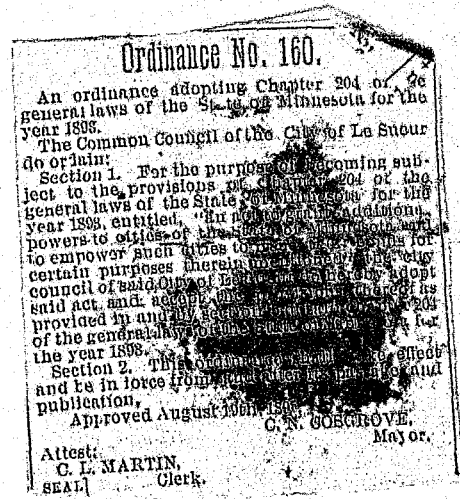

Certified Copy of Ordinance No. 160.

An Ordinance adopting Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.

The Common Council of the City of Le Sueur do ordain.

Section 1. For the purpose of becoming subject to the provisions of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893, entitled "an act to grant additional powers to cities of the State of Minnesota and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned" the Common Council of said City of Le Sueur do hereby adopt said act and accept the provisions thereof as provided in and by section 5 of said Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

At a special meeting of the common
council of the city of Le Sueur, Minnesota,
held on the 19th day of August, 1895, and
called for this purpose the attached ord-

Resolution

At a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Le Sueur, Minn., held on the 6th day of Sept., 1895, the following resolution was adopted by unanimous vote of all the aldermen present, only one alderman, (E. Vollbrecht) being absent. The resolution is as follows:

"That a special ^{election} be held on the 1st day of October, 1895, for the purpose of voting on the question of issuing bonds of this city in the sum of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20000) for the purpose of raising money for putting in water-works and electric light plant in said city. Said bonds to run for a period of Twenty (20) years and to bear interest at the rate of 5% per annum."

Those voting in favor of the resolution are as follows. H. F. Meyer, A. Treumann, C. J. Dressell, J. McMuliff, E. J. Lynch, W. A. Nays, none.
