ORDINANCE NO. 50.

An Ordinance accepting the provisions of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year A.D. 1893.

The City Council of the City of Chaska does Ordain:

Sec. 1 That the provisions of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year A.D. 1893, entitled "An Act to grant additional powers to cities of the state of Minnesota and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned." Approved April 12th A.D. 1893, be and are hereby accepted by the City of Chaska and that said city be subject to all of the provisions of said act to the same extent as though the same were originally incorporated as a part of the Charter of said City.

Sec. 2- This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its due approval.
