That the City of Winona, in the State of Minnesota, hereby becomes subject to the provisions of an act of the State of Minnesota entitled, "An Act to Authorize Cities to springle its streets, lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds and assess the cost thereof, on abutting property." Approved April 15, 1895.

SECTION II. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
