ORDINANCE NO. 131,

An Ordinance accepting and adopting chapter two hundred and thirty-three (233) of the General Laws of the state of Minnesota for the year A. D. 1895, the same being an act of the legislature of said state authorizing cities to sprinkle streets, lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds, and assess the cost thereof on abutting property. The city council of the city of Red Wing do ordain:

Section 1. That chapter two hundred and thirty-three (233) of the General Laws of the state of Minnesota, passed during the twenty-ninth session of the legislature of said state, which commenced on the eighth day of January, A. D. 1895, and which act was approved on the 15th day of April, A. D., 1895, and is entitled "An act to authorize cities to sprinkle its streets, lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds, and assess the cost thereof on abutting property" be, and each and every section and provision thereof is hereby accepted and adopted by the city of Red Wing, in the county of Goodhue, state of Minnesota; and the said city of Red Wing is hereby made subject to, and shall be governed, controlled and regulated by and under the provisions of said act.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.

That said newspaper, during all the time hereinafter set forth, and for more than one year next preceding the date of the first publication hereinafter mentioned, has been printed and published daily in the English language, and generally circulated in the City of Red Wing, and in the County of Goodhue and State of Minnesota; and during all said time consisted of a collection of reading matter in columns and sheet form and general and local news, comments, miscellaneous literary items, in size not less than four pages, of five columns to each page, each column not less than seventeen and three-quarter inches long. That said newspaper was so printed and published and generally circulated on every week day of each week at and from an established office and known place of business, equipped with the necessary materials and skilled workmen for preparing and printing the same, in the City of Red Wing, in the said county at which place it is dated; that during all the time herein stated the proprietors of said newspaper have printed, published and delivered at each regular issue more than two hundred and forty complete copies of said newspaper to paying subscribers. That the publishers of said newspaper have filed with the county auditor of said county of Goodhue, an affidavit in writing, subscribed by the affiant and duly sworn to before an officer authorized to administer oaths, stating among other things the name of the city and county where said newspaper is printed and published, and that said newspaper is a daily newspaper, and the days of the week on which the same is issued, and that the number of regular paid subscribers of said newspaper exceeds two hundred and forty, as required in and by Chapter 33 of the General Laws of said state for the year A. D. 1893, and the amendments thereto.

That said Ordinance hereto attached and made a part hereof, was

cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was published in said newspaper for successive weeks, at least

once in each week, that said notice was first published in said newspaper on Monday the Eighteenth

day of May A. D. 1896, and was thereafter published in said newspaper on each and every

successive week until and including the day

1896, and that during all said period said newspaper was regularly published on every week day of each week; and that the

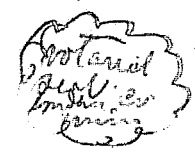

in favor of the said passage and adoption of said Ordinance,
to-wit: B. F. Siez; E. H. Hoard; Ed. Johnson; Fred. See-
bach; A. G. Skoglund; C. A. Erickson; M. Kappel; G. A.
Carlson and A. Remmler. That none of the said aldermen vot-
ed against the said passage and adoption of said Ordinance.
That the whole number of votes in favor of the said pass-
age and adoption of said Ordinance was nine (9). That there

were no votes against the said passage and adoption of said Ordinance. That said Ordinance was duly approved by the Mayor of said City of Red Wing on the 16th day of May, A. D., 1896. That said Ordinance was duly published in the Red Wing Daily Republican, the official paper of said city on the 18th day of May, A. D., 1896.
