

ORDINANCE NUMBER TEN.

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT CHAPTER TWO HUNDRED AND THIRTY THREE OF THE GENERAL LAWS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA FOR THE YEAR, 1895, ENTITLED AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE TO SPRINKLE ITS STREETS, LANES, ALLEYS AND PUBLIC GROUNDS AND ASSESS THE COSTS THEREOF, ON ABUTTING PROPERTY.
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MELROSE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Chapter Two Hundred and Thirty Three of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota of the year, 1895, entitled an act to authorize cities to sprinkle its streets, lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds and to assess the costs thereof on abutting property, be and the same is hereby adopted and hereby made applicable to the City of Melrose.

Section II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication and after a duly certified copy thereof is filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
