ADDENDUM TO ORDINANCE EXTENDING
CONTAINED IN AND UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 470
OF THE CITY OF NORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA

I, Gene A. Johnson, being first duly sworn, state that I am
the City Engineer of the City of Northington, Nobles County,
Minnesota, and that I prepared the description as contained in
Ordinance No. 470 wherein the corporate limits of the City of
Northington, Minnesota, were extended to include certain unplatted
lands.

I further state that there was a certain tract of land included
in that description which was not positioned for annotation and
should have been excluded in the description and annotation. The
description of the property to be included is as follows:

That Part of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) of the Southeast
Quarter (1/4) of Section 15, Township 102, Range 40, bounded
and described as follows: Commencing at the center of said
Section 15 and running thence due south, a distance of
118 feet to the center of the Diagonal Road running through
said Section 15; thence running southeasterly along the
center of said public road, a distance of 1091.6 feet;
thence south and parallel with the west line of said
southeast quarter to the southerly right-of-way line
of the existing highway as the place of beginning; thence
west and parallel with the north line of said southeast
quarter a distance of 45 feet; thence north and parallel
to the west line of said southeast quarter to the southerly
right-of-way line of the existing highway; thence southeasterly
along the southerly line of the existing highway right-of-way
to the place of beginning.


Enclosed please find the Affidavit to Correct Description Contained in Annexation Ordinance 470.

Page 1 -- Ordinance No. 170 -- Amended

That part of the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of the southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 15, Township 12N, Range 13E, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the center of said Section 15 and running thence due south, a distance of 110 feet to the center of the diagonal road running through said Section 15; thence running southeasterly along the center of said public road, a distance of 1071.6 feet; thence north and parallel with the west line of said southeast quarter to the easterly right-of-way line of the existing highway at the place of beginning; thence west and parallel with the north line of said southeast quarter a distance of 45 feet; thence north and parallel to the west line of said southeast quarter to the easterly right-of-way line of the existing highway; thence southeasterly along the easterly line of the existing highway right-of-way to the place of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described as 3.83 acres.

Section 3. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Hibdon County and the Board of Commissioners for Worthington Township on September 10, 1970, that said petition was being considered by the City Council of the City of Worthington and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Worthington, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 4. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Worthington, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein does not upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 5. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 6.

RESOLUTION NO. 27 OF 1911

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE VARIOUS LOTS OF THE CITY OF NORTHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO BECOME PART OF THE CITY.

The City Council of the city of Northington do ordain:

Section 1. Petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Northington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following real estate, to have such property included within the City of Northington, Minnesota:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 100, Range 10, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the center line of said Section 15 and running thence due south, a distance of 110 feet to the center of the diagonal road running through said Section 15; thence running southeasterly along the center of said public road a distance of 1091.8 feet; thence south parallel with the east line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15 to a point on the southerly right-of-way line of said highway; thence west and parallel with the north line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15, a distance of 15 feet to the place of beginning, each place of beginning being the northwest corner of the tract heretofore conveyed by first party to second party in that certain deed recorded in Book 119 of Deeds in page 352-353 in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Nobles County, Minnesota; thence west and parallel with the north line of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15 a distance of 150 feet; thence at right angles north a distance of 390 feet, more or less, to the north line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of said Section 15; thence east on said north line a distance of 150 feet to the northwest corner of the tract described in the deed between the parties above referred to; thence north along the west line of such tract described in such previous deed a distance of 390 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning,

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section 15, Township 100, Range 10, bounded and described as follows: Starting at the Northwest corner of the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of said Section 15 and running thence east on the forty acre line a distance of 700.4 feet to the place of beginning; thence north and parallel to the west line of the SW 1/4 of said Section 15, a distance of 161.3 feet; thence east and parallel with the forty acre line a distance of 15 feet to the center of the diagonal road; thence southeast on the center line of said diagonal road a distance of 300.2 feet; thence south and parallel to the west line of the SW 1/4 of said Section 15, a distance of 261.5 feet to the forty acre line; thence west on the said line a distance of 175.6 feet to the place of beginning,



AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE CONVEYANCE OF THE CITY OF WASHINGTON, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS.

The City Council of the City of Washington Do Ordain:

Section 1. Petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Washington, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners in number of the following real estate, to have such property included within the City of Washington, Minnesota:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) of Section 15, Township 102, Range 40, bounded and described as follows: Starting at the Northwest corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of said Section 15 and running thence east on the forty acre line a distance of 785.4 feet to the place of beginning; thence north and parallel to the west line of the SW 1/4 of said Section 15, a distance of 474.3 feet; thence east and parallel with the forty acre line a distance of 45 feet to the center of the diagonal road; thence southeast on the center line of said diagonal road a distance of 220.2 feet; thence south and parallel to the west line of the SW 1/4 of said Section 15, a distance of 261.5 feet to the forty acre line; thence west on the said line a distance of 273.6 feet to the place of beginning,

Section 1. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described as follows:

Section 2. Notice was duly given the Board of Commissioners for Indian County and the Board of Commissioners for Washington Township on September 20, 1970, that said petition was being considered by the City Council of the City of Northampton and a hearing was duly held by the City Council of the City of Northampton, on the proposed annexation after publication of notice of hearing as required by City Charter.

Section 3. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Northampton, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein shall upon the City and its successors as property to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1, and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and upon filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 5.
