ORDIMANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE EXTERDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF TWIN VALLEY TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND HEREIN DESCRIBED AND LOCATED IN THE WORTHWEST QUARTER OF THE WORTHEAST QUARTER (NF.NEW)

IN SECTION TWENTY-EIGHT (23) OF WILD PICE TOWNSHIP.

MORNAN COUNTY, MINNESOTA

WHEPEAS, A Petition was presented to, and filed with, the Village Council of the Village of Twin Valley on June 10, 1971, copies of said Petition also having been filed on June 10, 1971, with the Town Board of the Township of Wild Rice and with the County Board of Norman County and with the Sunfalpal Commission of Minnacota, which Petition was signed by a majority of the owners of the tract of land described therein, and tract not exceeding forty (40) acres in area, and which requested the Annemation of Said tract to the Village of Twin Valley: and whereas, no objections to the Annemation thereof were received within sixty (60) days thereafter from the Township of Wild Rice,

Norman County or any other municipality; and whereas, a Mearing on Said Annemation was held on September 20, 1971, at 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the Village Hall in the Village of Twin Valley, after thirty (30) days mailed Notice was given to all of the property owners within the area to be annexed; and whereas, no objections to said Annexation were voiced at said Hearing, now therefore

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLACE OF TWIN VALLEY, MINNESOTA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN:

Section 1. DECLARATION. It is hereby determined that the hereinafter described tract is unplatted land not exceeding forty (40) acres in area; that said tract abutts on the West boundary of the Village of Twin Valley and is not presently included within the corporate limits of any municipality; that said tract is urban in character; and that the Annexation thereof would be in the best interests of the Village of Twin Valley and of said tract.

Section 2. TERRITORY ANNEXED. The corporate limits of the Village of Twin Valley are hereby extended to include the tract of land described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (INFNE) of Section Twenty-eight (28), Township One Hundred Forty-four (144), Range Forty-four (44), which point is also the Southwest corner of Oppegard's Addition to the Village of Twin Valley; thence North on the West line of 4th Street in the Village of Twin Valley, which line is also the East line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (WWANE), to a point where oald line intersects the Westerly right-of-way line of State Highway No. Thirty-two (32); thence continuing Northwesterly,

on the Westerly right-of-way line of seld Highway No. Thirtytwo (32), to the North line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NV:NV:); thence Westerly, on the North line of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NWANEW), to the Northwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NWANE); thence Southerly, on the West line of sald Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NN/NE%), to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NVANEX); thence Easterly, on the South line of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NWANEA), to the Southeast corner of said Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (MANDA), being the point of beginning.

Section 3. FILING. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Counission, the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of Morman County, and the Town Clerk of the Township of Wild Rice.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication and the filing of the copies as directed in Section 3 herein.
