
Honorable Sir:





ORDINANCE NO. 349

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LAND

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DETROIT LAKES, MINNESOTA, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: A petition has been filed with the governing body of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, signed by all of the owners of the following described real estate, to have such described land included within the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota:

A tract of land located in Section 26, Township 139 North, Range 141 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the South line of Section 26 which bears Easterly 175.0 feet from the Southwest corner thereof; thence running Easterly in the South line of the said Section 26 to the South Quarter Corner thereof (iron pipe); thence running North 330.0 feet in the East line of the said S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ to an iron stake; thence running Westerly 1891.7 feet parallel with the South line of said Section 26 to an iron stake; thence running Northerly 9.6 feet by deflecting to the right at an angle of 91 degrees 05 minutes to an iron stake; thence running Westerly 400.0 feet by deflecting to the left at an angle of 90 degrees 00 minutes to an iron stake; thence running Southerly 74.5 feet by deflecting to the left at an angle of 89 degrees 41 minutes to an iron stake; thence running Westerly 177.0 feet by deflecting to the right at an angle of 88 degrees 38 minutes to an iron stake at the Northeast corner of a tract of land described in a Warranty Deed filed for record in Book 180 of Deeds at Page 513 in the office of the Register of Deeds, Becker County, Minnesota; thence running Southerly 273.0 feet in the Easterly line of the aforesaid tract by deflecting to the left at an angle of 89 degrees 01 minutes, to the point of beginning and there terminating; SUBJECT to an easement in the public for road or street purposes on the South 33.0 feet thereof; contains 18.6 acres.

Section 2: The City Council hereby determines; (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City of Detroit Lakes and is so conditioned as property to be subjected to the City government.

Section 3: Therefore, the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.

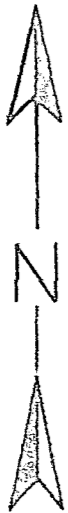

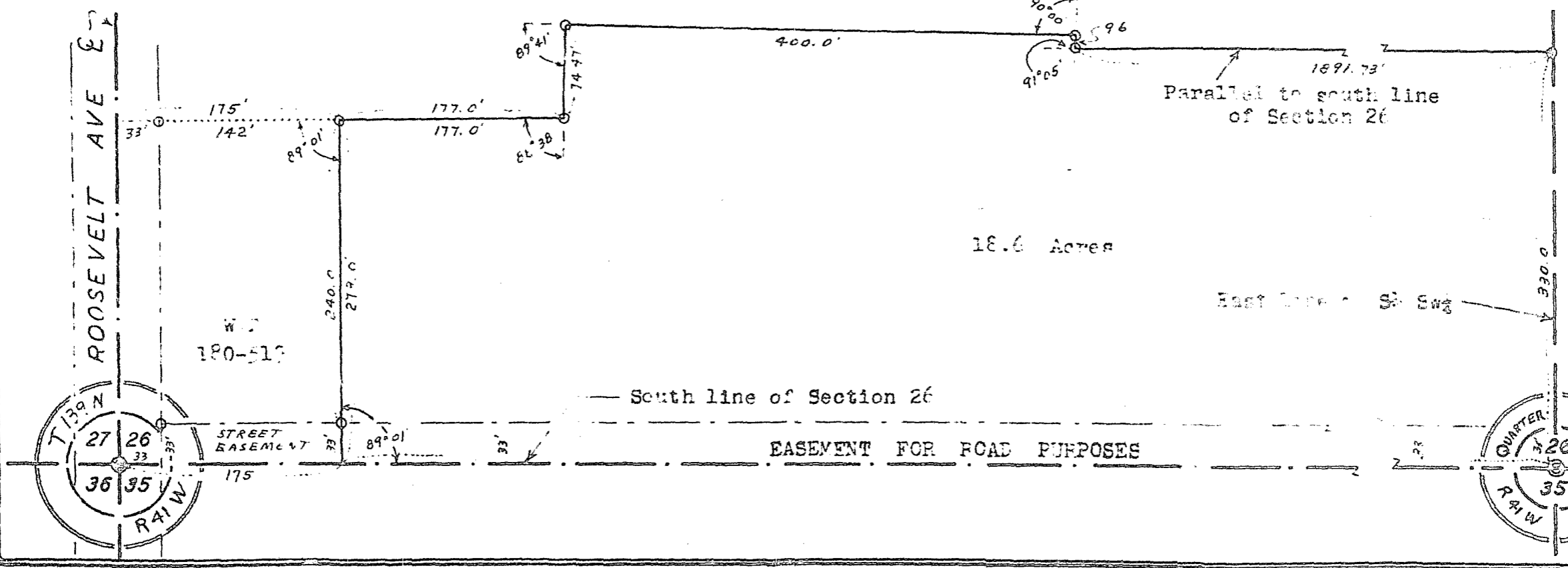
