ORDINANCE NO. 52.

An ordinance to make the City of Chaska subject to the provisions of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota, for the year 1893, Entitled "An Act to grant additional powers to cities of the State of Minnesota and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned," and the several acts amendatory thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHASKA DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Chaska does hereby accept and become subject to the provisions of Chapter 204 of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893, Entitled "An Act to grant additional powers to Cities of the State of Minnesota, and to empower such cities to issue their bonds for certain purposes therein mentioned," and the several acts amendatory thereof, and said City shall henceforth be governed, controlled and regulated by and under the provisions of said act and the acts amendatory thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and due publication.

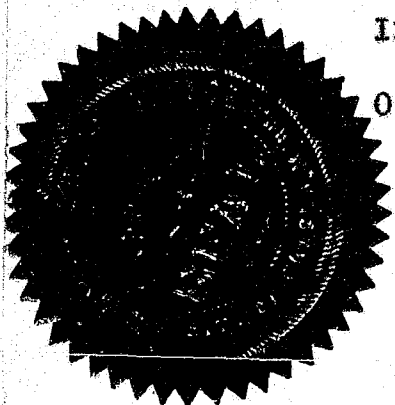
