ORDINANCE NO. 142 - AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CITY LIMITS

The City Council of the City of Dawson, Minnesota, dows hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that that tract of land situated in Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 349.4 feet west of and 578 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW1/4 SE1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township One Hundred Seventeen North (117N), of Range Forty-Three West (43W), thence N. 00 degrees 00 minutes a distance of 173.00 feet; thence N. 90 degrees 00 minutes W. a distance of 267.72 feet to the East line of Vold's First Addition to the City of Dawson; thence S. 00 degrees 41 minutes West along said East line a distance of 173.00 feet; thence S. 90 degrees 00 minutes East a distance of 267.72 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.
