Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that the tract of land situated in the City of Dawson, Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 549.4 feet west of and 378 feet north of the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (1/4 1/4) of Section Fifteen (15) in Township One Hundred Sixteen North (117 N), of Range Forty-three West (43 W), thence N. 00 degrees 00 minutes a distance of 175.00 feet; thence N. 90 degrees 00 minutes E. a distance of 237.72 feet to the East line of Vold's First Addition to the City of Dawson; thence S. 00 degrees 41 minutes West along said East line a distance of 175.00 feet; thence S. 10 degrees 00 minutes East a distance of 237.72 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning,

Section 3. That all of said tract described in Section 1 hereof is hereby annexed to the City of Dawson for all governmental

and hereby is hereby zoned as commercial district property and is assigned to and made a part of the First Ward of the City of Dawson.

ORDINANCE NO. 142
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING
CITY LIMITS

PRINTERS AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

The City Council of the City of Dawson, Minnesota, does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby found and determined that that tract of land situated in Lac qui Parle County, Minnesota described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 349.4 feet west of and 578 feet North of the Southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township One Hundred Seventeen North (117N), of Range Forty-Three West (43W), thence N. 00 degrees 00 minutes a distance of 173.00 feet; thence N. 90 degrees 00 minutes W, a distance of 267.72 feet to the East line of Vold's First Addition to the City of Dawson; thence S. 00 degrees 41 minutes West along said East line a distance of 173.00 feet; thence S. 90 degrees 00 minutes East a distance of 267.72 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

abuts on and is immediately adjacent to the northerly limits of the City of Dawson, Minnesota, and is presently agricultural land but is suitable and adaptable to residential and commercial development, and is adapted to urban government, and that it is adapted for use as a commercial district, and that it is to the best interests of the City of Dawson and of said above described territory that it be annexed to the City of Dawson for all government purposes.

Section 2. That all of said tract described in Section 1 hereof is hereby annexed to the City of Dawson, Minnesota for all governmental purposes and that the city limits of the City of Dawson are hereby extended and enlarged to include the same, and that all thereof is hereby zoned as commercial district property and is assigned to and made a part of the First Ward of the City of Dawson.

That this ordinance shall be in effect from and after final passage and publication and that true and correct copies thereof to be forwarded to and filed with Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor of Lac Qui Parle County, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, as provided by Rule 16 (a) of Minnesota Municipal Commission Rules of Practice.

Norman Bacon, being duly sworn, on oath, says he is and during all the times herei stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Dawson Sentinel, and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Dawson in the County of Lac qui Parle and it has its known office of issue in the City of Dawson in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966, and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of newspaper, and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
