CHAPTER 4.08

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A TRACT OF LAND ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE OF FOSSTON IN THE COUNTY OF POLK AND STATE OF MINNESOTA TO SAID VILLAGE SO AS TO BECOME A PART THEREOF.

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the tract of land hereinafter described abutting upon the Village of Fosston in the County of Polk and State of Minnesota (hereinafter referred to as "the village") a municipal corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota and having less than ten thousand inhabitants, have petitioned the Village Council of the Village to have said tract of law! ensemed to the Village, and to have said Council by ordinance declare said tract of land to be an addition to the Village to the end that such territory shall become a part of the Village as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof, all in accordance with Section 474.033 of Minnesota Statutes 1941. Now, THEREFORE

The Village Council of the Village of Wooston in the County of Polk and State of Minnesota, Do Ordain:


Section 1. The trant of land rithmood in the County of Polk and State of Minnesota butting upon the Village and Countied as follows, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Guarder (SEA NV)), except the East 406 feet of the Torth 80%. På feet thereof, Section Whree (3), Township One Hundred Forty-over (40) North of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Frincipal Feeddian,

is hereby declared to be annowed to said Village of Fonston, which territory hereby becomes a part of said Willers as effectually as if it had been originally a part thereof.

Section 2. That the Millings Older of the Fallage of Freedom is directed to file certified copies of This Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of lessable County and the Secretary of States

Section 3. This Ordinance shall have effort and be in force from and after its passage, publication and the dilling of copies of the Ordinance as provided in Section 2 harmes.
