= Ordinance No. 96 =

An Ordinance to continue what territory in the City of St. Charles shall be sprinkled in the year 1899, and to provide for the supervision and inspection of said work:

The City Council of the City of St. Charles do ordain:—

Section 1. That there shall be sprinkled by the City of St. Charles during the sprinkling season for the year 1899, all the streets and parts of streets described as follows:— Commencing at the crossing of Hoyt and Lomb Streets, thence north on Lomb and Whitewater Street to Duane Street.

Section 2. That all such streets and parts of streets as mentioned shall be sprinkled by the City of St. Charles from sidewalk to sidewalk during the sprinkling season for the year 1899.

Section 3. Such sprinkling to be done by virtue of a separate contract hereafter to be awarded by the City Council of said City as provided by law. The expense of such sprinkling to be borne by and chargeable to the several lot owners.

Section 4. The Police Marshall of the  
City of St. Charles shall be superintend-  
-ant of all sprinkling which said coun-  
-cil may authorize and shall cause the  
same to be done in accordance with the  
contract plans and specifications therefor.

Section 5. This Ordinance is made fur-  
-nished to the provisions of Chapter 233 of  
General Laws 1895 entitled "An act to  
authorize cities to sprinkle its streets,  
lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds,  
and assess the cost thereon on abutting  
property."

Section 6. This Ordinance shall  
take effect and be in force from and  
after its publication.
