- Ordinance No. 96 -

An Ordinance to establish what territory in the City of St. Charles shall be sprinkled in the year 1899, and to provide for the supervision and inspection of said work:

The City Council of the City of St. Charles do enact:—

Section 1. That there shall be sprinkled by the City of St. Charles during the sprinkling season for the year 1899, all the streets and parts of streets described as follows:—Beginning at the corner of Hoyt and Lamb Streets, thence north on Lamb and Whitewater Street to Division Street.

Section 2. That all such streets and parts of streets as mentioned shall be sprinkled by the City of St. Charles from sidewalk to sidewalk during the sprinkling season for the year 1899.

Section 3. Such sprinkling to be done by virtue of a separate contract hereafter to be awarded by the city council of said City as provided by law. The expense of such sprinkling to be borne by and chargeable to the same lot.

Section 4. The Police Marshall of the
City of St. Charles shall be superintend-
ent of all sprinkling which said com-
mission may authorize and shall cause the
same to be done in accordance with the
contract plans and specifications therefor.

Section 5. This Ordinance is made pur-
suant to the provisions of Chapter 233 of
General Laws 1875 entitled "An act to
authorize cities to sprinkle its streets,
lanes, alleys, avenues and public grounds,
and assess the cost thereof - on abutting
property."

Section 6. This Ordinance shall
take effect and be in force from and
after its publication.


