ORDINANCE NUMBER 111

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ROCKFORD, MINNESOTA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Whereas, Walter G. Kottenacker and Irene Kottenacker, husband and wife, filed a Petition for Annexation of land in Rockford Township, Wright County, Minnesota, with the Village Clerk of the said Village on August 9th, 1971, as to the hereinafter described realty, and,

WHEREAS, the perimeter of the area to be annexed to said Village is sixty (60) percent or more bordered by the municipality, and,

WHEREAS, The said municipality served a notice of intent to annex said realty upon the Clerk of the Rockford Township Board, on August 10th, 1971, and,

WHEREAS, the said Town Board has filed to serve objections to said annexation with the Commission, within the sixty (60) days allowed by law

NOW THEREFORE, Per-

uant to Section 414.033 Subd. 3 the said land described in said Petition, marked Exhibit "A" and described as follows, shall be annexed to the Village of Rockford, Minnesota, as follows, to wit:

That part of the Northwest Quarter and that part of the Southwest quarter, all in Section 19, Township 119, Range 24, Wright County, Minnesota, lying Southeasterly of the Sea Line Railroad and Northwesteasterly of the center line of Maple Street (as now laid out and travelled).

And that part of the East Half of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 119, Range 24, Wright County, Minnesota, lying Northwesteasterly of the center line of Maple Street (as now laid out and travelled).

Subject to an easement for roadway purposes over and across the Southeasterly 33.00 feet thereof.

The within Ordinance was passed by the Village Council of the Village of Rockford, Minnesota, on the 11th day of October, 1971.
