ORDINANCE NO. 167

AN ORDINANCE EXTEND ING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LE CENTER TO IN-CLUDE CERTAIN UNIN-CORPORATED UNPLAT-TED LANDS NOT EX-CEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a petition requesting the annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Village Council; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is less than 200 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners

of said land; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation has been received from the town boards, the county boards, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundar. ies abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition is completely within the Village limits:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Le Center, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1. The Village Council hereby determined (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein is completely within the village limits and is urban or sub: urban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.
