ORDINANCE NO. 466

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PROPERTY OWNED BY AND ABUTTING UPON THE LIMITS OF THE CITY.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter $(NK_4^1SK_4^1)$ of Section Nine (9), in Township One Hundred Eleven (111) north, of Range Forty-one (41) west, described as follows: Commencing at the west one-quarter corner of Section 9, Township 111 north, Range 41 west, thence Southerly on the west line of said Section 9, 324.95 feet, thence Easterly at right angles to last line a distance of 33 feet to the point of beginning; thence Southerly on a line 33 feet east and parallel with the west section line of said Section 9, a distance of 562 feet; thence Easterly and at right angles to last line, a distance of 562 feet; thence Northerly and at right angles to last line, a distance of 562 feet; and thence Westerly and at right angles to last line, a distance of 562 feet; and thence Westerly and at right angles to last line, a distance of 562 feet; and thence Westerly and at right angles to last line, a distance of 559 feet to the point of beginning, containing 7.21 acres, more or less, and subject to existing easements.

<u>Section 2.</u> The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description as bounded and described, is 7.2 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determined (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the properties hereinbefore described be and the same are hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if they had been originally a part thereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Clerk of Lake Marshall Township, the County Auditor of Lyon County and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
