ORDER FOR RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, The Honorable Martin A. Nelson, Associate Justice of
the Supreme Court of Minnesota, has heretofore on January 3, 1972 filed
with the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota a written application
for his retirement, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota has
determined that said Associate Justice Martin A. Nelson is eligible for
retirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of
Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section
490.025, do hereby order and direct the retirement of The Honorable Martin A.
Nelson, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of Minnesota, effective
January 3, 1972, and direct that this order be filed in the office of the
Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota and that said Martin A. Nelson
shall be entitled, from and after January 3, 1972, to retirement compensation
as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 490.025,
Subdivision 2.
