## STATE OF MINNESOTA DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION REORGANIZATION ORDER NO. 9

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1969 Sections 16.125, 16.13, and 16.135,

I, Richard L. Brubacher, as Commissioner of Administration do hereby order the transfer of functions, positions, and appropriations as set forth below and as approved by the Governor, such order to become effective October 1, 1971

The "State Organized Crime Control Unit" and its functions as defined in a grant from the Law Enforcement Assistance Administrative through the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control is hereby transferred from the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to the Office of the Attorney General.

The following vacant positions are hereby transferred from the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to the Office of the Attorney General:

Public Safety, B.C.A. F.Y. 1972 Roster Nos.

1299, 1381, 1382, 1383, 1384, 1385, 1386, 1387, 1388, one half of 1369.

One position from 1971-73 LAC Order No. 2, Section 7.

The following appropriations are hereby transferred from the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to the Office of the Attorney General:

The amount listed in (1) above was appropriated to the Department of Public Safety, by Extra Session Laws 1971, Chapter 3, and the amounts listed in (2) and (3) were authorized by LAC Order No. 2. The three amounts are subsequently transferred by this order to the Office of the Attorney General.

The purpose of this order is to enable the Office of the Attorney General to carry out the Organized Crime Control Project authorized by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration through the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control by providing sufficient funds and positions to match the federal grant.

One position herein transferred terminates on July 1, 1972 unless otherwise extended by the Legislative Advisory Committee.

Funds herein transferred are intended to provide for the nine months ending July 1, 1972.

An additional transfer of funds from the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the Criminal Justice Contingency is anticipated in June, 1972 for Fiscal Year 1973.
