The purpose of this order is to enable the Office of the Attorney General to carry out the Organized Crime Control Project authorized by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration through the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control by providing sufficient funds and positions to match the federal grant.

One position herein transferred terminates on July 1, 1972 unless otherwise extended by the Legislative Advisory Committee.

Funds herein transferred are intended to provide for the nine months ending July 1, 1972.

An additional transfer of funds from the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Criminal Apprehension and the Criminal Justice Contingency is anticipated in June, 1972 for Fiscal Year 1973.


