AMENDMENT NO. 9. To amend Chapter IX. of the Charter of St. Paul by adding at the end thereof the following new section. viz. "Section 34. The Common Council of the City of St. Paul shall have the power, upon request of the Board of Water Com-missioners without first submitting the question to the voters of the City, to issue and sell not exceeding Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) par value in and of the bonds of said City, for the purpose of, and the proceeds thereof to be used solely for, extending, enlarging and improving the public water plant and waterworks system owned and operated by eaid City, provided that not more than One Hundred Fity Thousand Dollars (\$150,000) par value of said bonds shall be issued in any one calendar year. "Said bonds shall be in form to be pre-scribed by the Common Council and shall be rate a rate not exceeding four per cent per annum, and shall be payable in not to exceed thirty years after the add notwithstanding any provisions of aw Bidding any maximum dimit-upon the bonded indebtedness of said city. "When said bonds for any of them are issued and sold, it shall be the duty of the Board of Water Commissioners to make suitable provision for the revenues of said water plant for the prompt paymont of said bonds at their maturity."

Know all men that these presents hereby certify that the foregoing draft of Amendments numbered one (1) and nine (9) of the proposed amendments to the charter of the City of St. Paul, in the County of Ramsey and State of Minnesota, as returned by the board of fifteen freeholders appointed by the judges of the District Court of the Second Judicial District of said State, under and pursuant to Article four, Section thirty-six of the Constitution of Minnesota, and Chapter 351 of the General Laws for the year 1899, and Chapter 238 of the General Laws of said State for the year 1903, to the chief magistrate of said City of St. Paul, to-wit, its mayor, Robert A. Smith, were each and all submitted to the qualified voters of said City of St. Paul at the general election held in said City on the 6th day of November, 1906, at which said election there were cast in favor of said Amendment numbered one (1) fourteen thousand, seven hundred eighty-two (14,782) votes, and there were cast in favor of said Amendment numbered nine (9) fourteen thousand, seven hundred sixty-five (14,765) yotes, and at said election each of said Amendments numbered one (1) and nine (9) did respectively receive the votes of more than three-fifths of the qualified voters voting at said election in said City, in favor of the adoption and ratification thereof, and each of said amendments did receive more than three-fifths of the total vote cast for any purpose at said election, in favor of the adoption of the same and of each thereof;

And know ye further, that all of the votes so cast by the qualified voters and electors at said election held on November 6th, 1906, upon the question of the ratification of said amendments were duly voted, returned and canvassed by the properly and duly authorized and official canvassing board in and for said City; and

Know ye further, that each and all of said amendments to

said charter numbered one (1) and nine (9) as aforesaid were duly and properly ratified and adopted by the duly qualified voters and electors of said City at said election.
