WHEREAS, the Minnesota State Legislature pursuant to Laws of 1971,
Chapter 951, has provided for a county court system in the State of
Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, said law provides that Carlton and Aitkin Counties shall
comprise one district unless by concurrence of both county boards
said counties shall comprise separate districts, and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Carlton County has determined that it
would be preferable for Carlton County to maintain a separate court
system,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the County Board of Carlton County
that Carlton County shall comprise a separate judicial district under
the provisions of Laws of 1971, Chapter 951, subject to similar approval
by Aitkin County as provided by law,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Auditor is hereby directed
to send copies of this resolution to the County Auditor of Aitkin
County and to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
