KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, have constituted and appointed

WILLIAM E. MULLIN

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to act for the Attorney General in the matter of State of Minnesota, et al., vs. American Cast Iron Pipe Co., et al. for the period commencing November 23, 1971. He shall be compensated at the rate of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per hour, plus all costs and expenses incurred in connection therewith (including, without limitation, travel, lodging, expert witness fees and deposition costs); provided, however, that the amount of such compensation shall be increased, in the event of a recovery by plaintiffs (whether by settlement or otherwise), to an amount equal to the lesser of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00) per hour or Fifteen Percent (15%) of the amount of such recovery. Such compensation shall be paid from the funds of the Department of the Attorney General. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.

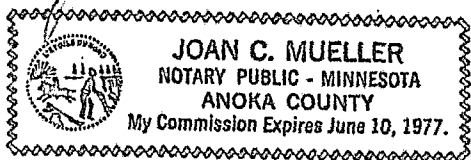
