ORDINANCL #109 AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF NORWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UN-PLATTED LANDS NOT EXCE-EDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. A petition having been filed with the governing body of the Village of Norwood, by John Kranz and Myrtle Kranz, his wife, the owners of the following described real estate, to have such lands included within the Village of Norwood, Carver County, Minnesota:

Tract A.
