PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the sport of bicycling has reached an all-time high in popularity, with over 65 million adults and children in the United States riding bicycles for recreation, health, and transportation; and

WHEREAS: the bicycle offers no abnormal stress to our natural physical and mental being and provides wholesome exercise and promotes physical fitness; and

WHEREAS: the bicycle allows participation in family-oriented activities; and

WHEREAS: there is a need to focus the attention of the public on the importance of bicycling as an alternative mode of transportation and as an aid to alleviating environmental and other health problems;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 8, 1971 as

"BIKEOLOGY DAY"

in Minnesota and all members of the public are encouraged to participate in such observance.
