WHEREAS: "our children are all children and our race is the human race," and

WHEREAS: it is the innocent children who are defenseless in the crises of the world, and

WHEREAS: Americans for Children's Relief is a non-profit organization dedicated to the needs of children wherever and whenever their health, safety and welfare are threatened, and

WHEREAS: in the short time of its existence, ACR has provided the difference between life and death for children in such disaster areas as Biafra, E. Pakistan and India, and has offered health care to children in the United States,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January, 1972, as the

MONTH OF HOPE FOR CHILDREN

and urge each citizen of Minnesota to support ACR in carrying out its many humanitarian programs.
