PROCLAMATION

THEREAS: The voluntary banding together of private citizens in mutual concern and reoponoibility to protect and preserve the rights and dignity of others becomes especially important in these increasingly critical times; and

WHEREAS: the National Council of Jewish Women comprised of deeply committed and involved women, has encouraged fulfillment of these obligations of citizenship as women, as Americans and as Jevs; and

the vitality and purpose and dedicated efforts of Council women have helped to improve our schools, our government, and our health and welfare services in Manasota and in other states throughout the country; and

the National Council of Jewish Women of Minnesota is always secking to enlarge its membership co as to broaden its vista, scope and field of action in behalf of the disadventaged of all faiths, creeds and netionalities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 9 - 15, 1972 as

"NATIONAL COUNCIL OF JEVISH VIONEN WEEK"

in Minnesota, so that the members of this vital organization may augment their numbers and their efforts to further freedom and human dignity.
