

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: The voluntary banding together of private citizens in mutual concern and responsibility to protect and preserve the rights and dignity of others becomes especially important in these increasingly critical times; and

WHEREAS: the National Council of Jewish Women comprised of deeply committed and involved women, has encouraged fulfillment of these obligations of citizenship as women, as Americans and as Jews; and

WHEREAS: the vitality and purpose and dedicated efforts of Council women have helped to improve our schools, our government, and our health and welfare services in Minnesota and in other states throughout the country; and

WHEREAS: the National Council of Jewish Women of Minnesota is always seeking to enlarge its membership so as to broaden its vista, scope and field of action in behalf of the disadvantaged of all faiths, creeds and nationalities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 9 - 15, 1972 as

"NATIONAL COUNCIL OF JEWISH WOMEN WEEK"

in Minnesota, so that the members of this vital organization may augment their numbers and their efforts to further freedom and human dignity.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-one, and of the State, the one hundred fourteenth.
