- WHEREAS: The mentally retarded citizens of Minnesota when properly trained and placed have established a respectable record of skill and mutually satisfactory long term employment in the food service industry of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota in cooperation with local governmental units and with the cooperation of Economics Laboratory, Inc. has developed the means for proper training and placement; and
- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Restaurant Association has recognized the value of hiring the mentally retarded and wishes to sponsor Coffee Day for the Mentally Retarded to raise the funds to more fully develop and expand the program; and
- WHEREAS: approximately 25 local Association for Retarded Children Chapters and their State Association endorses this program; and
- WHEREAS: the Governor's Commission on Employment of Handicapped Persons endorses this program,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim December 2, 1971 as

"COFFEE DAY"

in Minnesota.
