WHEREAS: the 17th annual meeting of the Minnesota Home Economics Association is being convened in Minneapolis, March 17 and 18, 1972;

WHEREAS: home economics in the field of knowledge and service primarily concerned with meeting the needs of men and families, and

WHEREAS: these needs are met through educating the individual for family living, improving the goods and services used by families, conducting research to discover changing needs of individuals and families and the means of satisfying these needs, and also through fostering community, national and world conditions favorable to family living, and

WHEREAS: home economists in Minnesota are making important contributions to both rural and urban families through teaching, business and extension service, as well as through participation in various international service programs,

NOW, WHEREAS, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 13 - 19, 1972 as

"HOMECOMING WEEK"

in Minnesota.
