- WHEREAS: Organized camping offers opportunities for the growth and development of our youth and emphasizes the importance of man's continuing to live together in a democratic society, and
- WHEREAS: camping also builds our boys and girls in habits of self-reliance and dignity of work; through interdependence, and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota provides endless natural resources for some of the finest private, organizational and church camps in the country, and
- WHEREAS: the American Camping Association has led the nation in spearheading higher standards for all types of camps so that the motto "AMERICAN CAMPING FOR ALL" can become a reality.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell P. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of March 5 - 11, 1972, as

"AMERICAN CAMPING WEEK"
