- WHEREAS: the need for a youth organization to provide for the students enrolled in office programs was recognized almost a decade ago, and
- WHEREAS: the Office of Education Association was established in 1966 as an independent youth organization for students enrolled in high school and post secondary office occupations education programs, and
- WHEREAS: membership in OEA is without regard to race, creed or national origin, and
- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Office Education Association was organized to help students develop their skills and leadership abilities through participation in vocational education, civic, recreational, and social activities,
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim one week of February 6 - 12, 1972, as

and urge all citizens to commend OEA for their worthwhile purpose in unifying students enrolled in classes with office employment as their objective.
