PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS: the snowmobile has provided Minnesotans with a healthy, invigorating winter sport that expands the enjoyment of our "Theatre of Seasons", and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota ranks as the leading state in number of snowmobiles produced, is second among all states in total number of snowmobiles registered, and has used registration fees to develop 3,000 miles of scenic snowmobile trails, and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota was the first state to develop comprehensive legislation governing the proper and safe use of these vehicles and the first state to conduct a driver training course that has already certified over 60,000 young snowmobilers, and
- WHEREAS: despite these positive accomplishments, the number of snowmobile fatalities in our State has risen this winter,

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 14 - 21, 1972 as

SAFE, FUN SNOWMOBILING WEEK

in Minnesota, a period when all snowmobile manufacturers, dealers and users pledge to expand their efforts for safe, responsible, considerate snowmobiling fun.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and of the State the one hundred fifteenth.
