ORDINANCE NO 2070

Introduced by Councilman  Gordon Aanerud

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated September 16, 1971 requesting annexation of the territory here-in after described was duly presented to the Council on the 26th day of October 1971, and,

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is approximately 5,000 sq. ft. of platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated City, Village or Borough and,

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners, and,

WHEREAS no objection to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board or the Governing Body of any Municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed, and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the governing body of the City of Albert Lea on the proposed annexation after at least a 60 day waiting period following notice of intent to annex the property, and,

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the Southerly boundary thereof.

THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA DOES ORDAIN:

Sec. 1. The City Council hereby determines (1.) That the annexation will be to the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2.) That the territory described here-in abuts upon the City limits and is urban or sub-urban in character (3.) That none of said territory is now included within the limits of any City, Village or Borough.

Sec. 2. The Corporate limits of the City of Albert Lea are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included with the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lot 9 of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, Township 102 North, Range 21, lying West of the Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific Railroad, as the same appears upon the plat of O.K. Hollis's Subdivision of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 17, Township 102 North, Range 21, Freeborn County, Minnesota

Sec. 3. That the above property is hereby zoned as R-1 Residential property.

Sec. 4. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.
