ORDINANCE NO. 7C-04

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS TO  
THE VILLAGE OF BYRON

The Village Council of the Village of Byron ordains that:

The following described premises located in the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4), Section 32, Township 107, Range 15, are hereby annexed to the Village of Byron, to wit:

Description: Beginning at the point of intersection of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company southerly right of way and the West line of Baack's Second Addition in the Village of Byron, Olmsted County, Minnesota; thence North 88° 57 minutes 30 seconds west (assumed) along the southerly right of way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway Company, a distance of 352.06 feet; thence south 97.03 feet; thence south 18° 46 minutes 50 seconds East a distance of 69.71 feet; thence south 0° 40 minutes East a distance of 342.50 feet; thence East a distance of 131.50 feet; thence south 59° 32 minutes 40 seconds East a distance of 76.98 feet; thence East 133.72 feet to the West line of Baack's Second Addition; thence North 0° 39 minutes West along said West line a distance of 538.17 feet to the point of beginning.
