Dear Dennis:

You have posed a question to me as to whether the elections for the Village of Delhi will be had this year the first Tuesday after the first Monday in December or the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.

The Village Council enacted an ordinance pursuant to M.S.A. 205.07 prior to September 1, 1970 electing to hold the election on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November. This ordinance was duly enacted and became effective upon publication which was done prior to the date mentioned.

Pursuant to this statute, thereafter the regular village election will be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November until the ordinance is revoked.

Evidently the Village Clerk did not notify the County Auditor and the Secretary of State of this change. Therefore, I am forwarding a copy of this letter to Mr. P. A. Byram, Redwood County Auditor, and to the Secretary of State, advising them.
