



ORDER FOR RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, the Honorable Leonard Keyes, Judge of District Court of Minnesota, the Tenth Judicial District, Minnesota, has heretofore filed with the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota his written application for retirement, said application having been made under and pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 490.101(1) and 490.102, Subd. 3 (1969), and the said Judge Keyes having applied for retirement within one year after becoming eligible for such retirement, and has served as such judge, or as such judge and as judge of a court of record, for more than 15 years,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Section 490.101 and 490.102, Subd. 3, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Leonard Keyes, effective at midnight on April 20, 1972. He shall become entitled thereafter to compensation as provided under the law, and I further direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.


