



ORDER FOR RETIREMENT

WHEREAS, The Honorable William P. Murphy, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of Minnesota, has heretofore, on April 4, 1972, filed with the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota a written application for his retirement, and

WHEREAS, the undersigned Governor of the State of Minnesota has determined that said Associate Justice William P. Murphy is eligible for retirement.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, § 490.025, do hereby order and direct the retirement of The Honorable William P. Murphy, Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of Minnesota, effective midnight, April 30, 1972, and direct that this order be filed in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota and that said William P. Murphy shall be entitled, from and after May 1, 1972, to retirement compensation, as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, § 490.025, Subdivision 2.
