

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: the future success of America will depend on learning to live, being able to learn; wanting to live, living to learn - establishing a direction of progress and the future welfare of our production agriculture, and agribusiness; and

WHEREAS: their 1972 theme is "FIA - Youth With A Purpose" and

WHEREAS: the FIA's main goal is to provide training in agribusiness and natural resources occupations, develop leadership, character, patriotism and citizenship among its members, thereby encouraging them to participate in building our communities, and to contribute significantly to our state and nation, and;

WHEREAS: this year marks the forty-second anniversary of the Minnesota Association of the FIA, an organization composed of 13,606 active members, who are studying vocational agriculture in 263 secondary schools, and providing an excellent background of training for FIA members planning to learn, enter agricultural college, or area vocational technical schools to be employed in one of the challenging and rewarding agribusiness and natural resources careers.
