

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: the future of our state and nation lies in the hands of the youth of today, and, therefore, one of our greatest obligations is to help develop in today's young people the qualities that will enable them to solve the needs of that future; and

WHEREAS: qualities of competence, respect for law, and a high sense of responsibility for the common welfare are essential qualities for the maintenance and development of healthy, happy and successful human lives and a high degree of social progress; and

WHEREAS: civic, educational, religious, social and other organizations can and do make a substantial contribution to the development of high moral, spiritual and social standards by programs of temperance education for youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell A. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 23rd - 29th, 1972, as

"YOUTH TEMPERANCE EDUCATION WEEK"

and urge that citizens in churches, schools, clubs, and as individuals, join in the observance of youth temperance education during this designated week; and further urge all Minnesotans to become alert to said education as a year around project.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this twenty-fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-two and of the State the one hundred thirtieth.
