NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 13 to February 19, 1972 as

"SCHOOL SAFETY PATROL WEEK"

in Minnesota, and do urge that all communities arrange special programs to give recognition to the boys and girls who so faithfully serve them.
