NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Tuesday, April 14, 1972 as

THE AMERICAN WAY

and the week beginning April 12, 1972 and ending April 18, 1972 as

THE AMERICAN WEEK

in Minnesota.
