ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF MAGNOLIA, MINNESOTA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, A certain Petition dated <u>November 10</u>, 1971, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the Council on the <u>loth</u> day of <u>November</u>, 1971; and

WHEREAS, The quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described is 11 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, The Petition was signed by and on behalf of the sole and exclusive owner of all of said lands; and

WHEREAS, No objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, The land described in the Petition abuts upon the village limits on the west boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAGNOLIA, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. The village council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included

within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The South 578 feet of the East 229 feet of the Southwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 102 North, of Range 44 West of the 5th P.M., in Magnolia Township, Rock County, Minnesota.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
