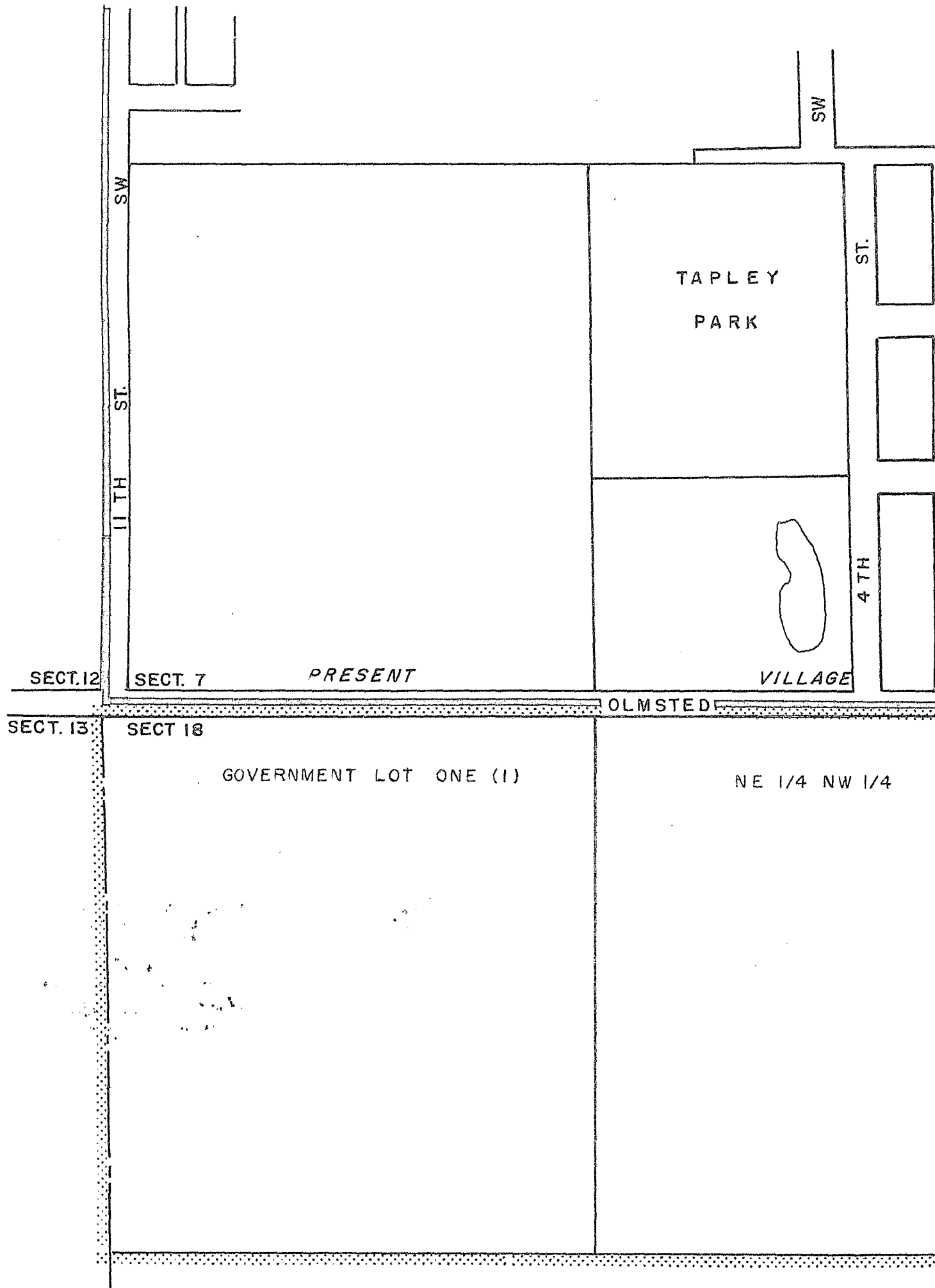

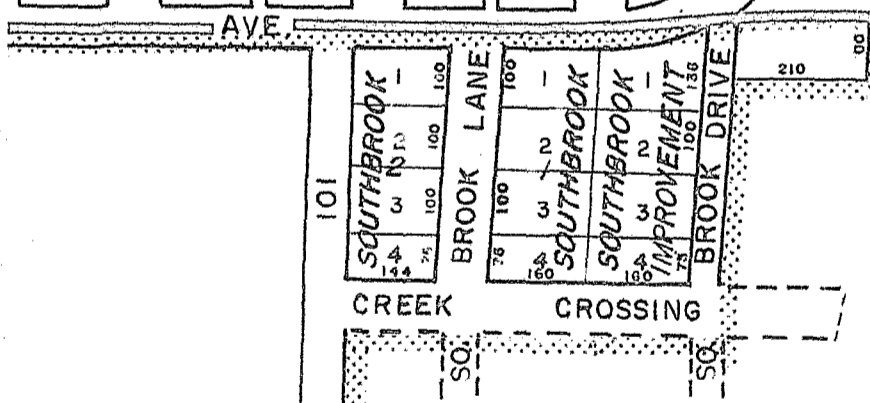

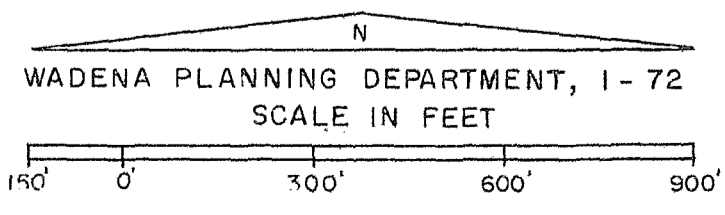

ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE VILLAGE OF WADENA TO INCLUDE CERTAIN
UNINCORPORATED PLATTED AND UNPLATTED LAND
ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated September 7, 1971, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 8th day of September, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described is seven and two-tenths (7.2) acres, more or less of platted land and seventy-nine and three-tenths (79.3) acres, more or less of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners except the United States of America, constituting a majority; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, said petition was served upon the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County of Wadena, and the Township of Wadena in addition to the village; and

WHEREAS, no objections were filed with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota to said annexation; and

WHEREAS, a hearing was duly held by the governing body of the Village of Wadena, Minnesota, on the proposed annexation after at least thirty (30) days mailed notice; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the southern boundary thereof;

The council of the Village of Wadena, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 132 of the Village of Wadena is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The Village Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is or is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included

within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 3. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the platted land described as follows:

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Block One (1) and Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Block Two (2) in Southbrook; and

Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) of Southbrook Improvements; and all roads and alleys adjacent thereto;

and the unplatted land described as follows:

Government Lot One (1) and the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) in Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Thirty-four (134), Range Thirty-five (35); and

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Eighteen (18), Township One Hundred Thirty-four (134), Range Thirty-five (35), described as follows: Commencing at the North Quarter corner of said Section 18, thence East on an assumed bearing 638.90 feet to the point of beginning, thence continuing East 210 feet along the Northerly line of said Section 18, thence South 4 $^{\circ}$ 12' West 100 feet; thence West 210 feet parallel to the Northerly line of said Section 18, thence North 4 $^{\circ}$ 12' East 100 feet to the point of beginning, and all roads and alleys adjacent thereto;

and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. Filing. The village clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 4.
