CITY CHARTER
OF THE
City of Hastings, Minnesota.
Adopted by the Charter Board,
March 17th, A. D. 1907.

CHAPTER I.
SHORT TITLE.

Sec. 1. All the parts of this charter of the city of Hastings, Minnesota, shall be known as the "City Charter of the City of Hastings, Minnesota," and shall be so cited hereinafter in this charter.

CHAPTER II.
OFFICERS AND ELECTIONS.

Sec. 2. The city shall be governed by a mayor, a city council and a board of trustees, who shall hold office for a term of four years, unless sooner removed or re-elected.

CHAPTER III.
THE CITY COUNCIL.

Sec. 3. The city council shall consist of seven members, who shall be elected by the voters of the city at large.

CHAPTER IV.
THE MAYOR.

Sec. 4. The mayor shall be elected by the voters of the city at large, for a term of four years.

CHAPTER V.
THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

Sec. 5. The board of trustees shall consist of five members, who shall be elected by the voters of the city at large.

CHAPTER VI.
FINANCE.

Sec. 6. The city shall have the power to levy taxes on all property within its limits, for the purpose of raising revenue for the city.

CHAPTER VII.
THE CITY CLERK.

Sec. 7. The city shall have the power to elect a city clerk, who shall hold office for a term of four years.

CHAPTER VIII.
THE CITY ENGINEER.

Sec. 8. The city shall have the power to employ a city engineer, who shall be responsible for the construction and maintenance of the city's public works.

CHAPTER IX.
THE CITY COMMISSIONERS.

Sec. 9. The city shall have the power to employ city commissioners to supervise the various departments of the city government.

CHAPTER X.
THE CITY ATTORNEY.

Sec. 10. The city shall have the power to employ a city attorney, who shall be responsible for the legal affairs of the city.

CHAPTER XI.
THE CITY BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Sec. 11. The city shall have the power to create a board of public works, which shall be responsible for the construction and maintenance of the city's public infrastructure.

CHAPTER XII.
THE CITY BOARD OF HEALTH.

Sec. 12. The city shall have the power to create a board of health, which shall be responsible for the public health and sanitation of the city.

CHAPTER XIII.
THE CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION.

Sec. 13. The city shall have the power to create a board of education, which shall be responsible for the management of the city's public schools.

CHAPTER XIV.
THE CITY BOARD OF CHARITIES.

Sec. 14. The city shall have the power to create a board of charities, which shall be responsible for the care of the city's poor and indigent.

CHAPTER XV.
THE CITY BOARD OF LABORERS.

Sec. 15. The city shall have the power to create a board of laborers, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's labor market.

CHAPTER XVI.
THE CITY BOARD OF ALCOHOLICS.

Sec. 16. The city shall have the power to create a board of alcoholics, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's alcohol consumption.

CHAPTER XVII.
THE CITY BOARD OF GAMING.

Sec. 17. The city shall have the power to create a board of gaming, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's gaming activities.

CHAPTER XVIII.
THE CITY BOARD OF THEATERS.

Sec. 18. The city shall have the power to create a board of theaters, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's theatrical performances.

CHAPTER XIX.
THE CITY BOARD OF CIRCUSES.

Sec. 19. The city shall have the power to create a board of circuses, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's circus performances.

CHAPTER XX.
THE CITY BOARD OF RACES.

Sec. 20. The city shall have the power to create a board of races, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's racing activities.

CHAPTER XXI.
THE CITY BOARD OF LOTTERIES.

Sec. 21. The city shall have the power to create a board of lotteries, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's lottery activities.

CHAPTER XXII.
THE CITY BOARD OF SWEETSHOPS.

Sec. 22. The city shall have the power to create a board of sweetshops, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's sweetshop activities.

CHAPTER XXIII.
THE CITY BOARD OF BAKERIES.

Sec. 23. The city shall have the power to create a board of bakeries, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's bakery activities.

CHAPTER XXIV.
THE CITY BOARD OF BUTCHERS.

Sec. 24. The city shall have the power to create a board of butchers, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's butchery activities.

CHAPTER XXV.
THE CITY BOARD OF FISHMONGERS.

Sec. 25. The city shall have the power to create a board of fishmongers, which shall be responsible for the regulation of the city's fishmongery activities.

Sec. 26. This charter shall be in full force and effect from the date of its adoption.
