of Marshall, Minnesota, as Special Counsel to act for the Attorney General for the period commencing February 1, 1972, for the purpose of assisting the College in collecting delinquent National Defense Education Act (NDEA) Loans and in such other matters as the College requests. He shall be paid for legal services rendered to the College at a reasonable hourly rate, to be paid from the funds budgeted to Southwest State College. He shall also be paid one-third of the total amount collected from the delinquent NDEA Loans. Said Special Counsel shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.



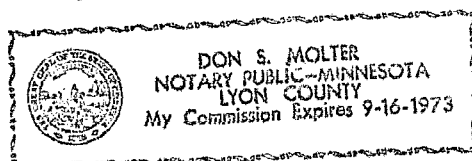


