Pursuant to M.S. 16.125, 16.13, and 16.135, the following administrative reorganization is hereby made:

 The administrative portion of the Notary Public function previously performed in the Governor's Office is hereby transferred to the Department of Commerce, Administrative Services Division, Examination and Licensing Section. This transfer does not effect the constitutional power of the Governor to make the appointments of Notaries Public, but is intended to improve the administrative portion of the appointment process.

The position of a Notarial Clerk, and its present incumbent, Mrs. Cathy A. Koolmo, are hereby transferred from the Governor's Office to the Department of Commerce, Administrative Services Division, Examination and Licensing Section.

The approved complement of the Department of Commerce is hereby increased by one position.

The salaries and supplies expense amounts for the Notarial Clerk are hereby transferred from the Governor's Office (12000:00–100) to the Department of Commerce, Salaries (20100:01–100) and Supply and Expenses (20100:02–100) as follows:
