

ORDINANCE NO. 30

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH  
A DATE FOR THE ANNUAL VILLAGE ELECTION

The Village Council of Oklee, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Date. That pursuant to the provisions of M.S.A. 205.07 et. seq., it is hereby determined that the Village of Oklee shall hold regular village elections annually on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November.

Section 2. Notice. The Village Clerk shall cause ten (10) days posted notice and may also cause two (2) weeks published notice of the annual village election to be given, specifying time and place, thereof, the offices to be filled, and the questions, if any, to be determined by vote.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
