

Amendments to the Charter of the City of Granite Falls, Minnesota.

Number one.

Amends section 1 of Chapter V of said charter so that it shall read as follows:-

"Section 1. The Fiscal year of the City of Granite Falls shall commence on the first day of December."

Amendment No. Two.

Amends section five of said Charter so that the same shall read as follows:-

Section 5. The City Council may issue time warrants when the fund on which the warrant would otherwise be drawn is exhausted, provided that at no time shall the aggregate warrants outstanding against all funds exceed the sum of three thousand dollars, and that said warrants shall bear interest at the legal rate: Provided, that for the purpose of completing the construction and equipment of the new dam, power house and electric light and waterworks plant begun during the year 1910, the City Council may issue such time warrants to an amount aggregating ten thousand dollars in excess of the amount herein above limited."
