

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners

of the County of Cass, and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned electors, residents upon the following described lands, which have been partly platted into lots and blocks, and upon lands adjacent thereto, in the County of Cass, State of Minnesota, and not in any incorporated village, which plats have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of this State, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds for the County in which said lands lie, to-wit: Section one (1) and the North East quarter of the North East quarter of section Two (2), in Township one hundred forty-one (141) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the Fifth principal meridian, containing six hundred eighty(680) acres of land; that the resident population thereof is not less than two hundred (200) nor more than three thousand (3000).

Hereby Petition, your honorable board, to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands, may vote for or against the incorporation under the Revised Laws of 1905, of a village to be named "R E M E R".

Commissioner A. J. Swanberg offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this board, a petition for the incorporation, as a village, of section one (1) and the North East quarter of the North East quarter of section two (2), of township one hundred forty-one (141) North, of Range twenty-six (26), in the County of Cass, State of Minnesota, to be called the Village of Remer, which petition in all manner and form complies with the laws of this State, and being signed by thirty-six electors, residents upon said land.

NOW WHEREFORE, Resolved, that said petition be hereby approved, and that an election be held, after giving due and legal notice of the same, on Saturday, the 6th day of January, 1912, from 9 o'clock in the forenoon until 4 o'clock in the afternoon of said day, at Shill's Hall, which is within the boundary of said proposed Village; that A. H. Glandon, A. E. Mills and W. A. Wickland, residents of the territory as defined in said petition, shall act as inspectors and judges of said election, and to conduct the same as far as practicable in accordance with the laws of this State, regulating the election of town officers.

Commissioner Spencer seconded the motion, and same was adopted by unanimous vote.
